



Above is a unique view showing the compartment occupied by the navigator and the wireless operator. The Bendix installation seen on the right and in the lower view comprises main and auxiliary transmitters, two complete receivers, a direction-finder and an inter-communication system which extends throughout the hull and permits both pilots to use the wireless directly when necessary. The loop aerial is extended through the roof and is remotely controlled from the wheel seen in the smaller view over the wireless operator's table. The cylinders by the navigator's table are drinking-water tanks.
